School meals

As previously advised, we regret to inform you that school meals will be increasing in price from September. The new cost will be **£2.75** per day for all children* in Y3 – Y6; and **£2.10** for Nursery-aged children. These prices have been negotiated with our caterers, Taylor Shaw, and apply across all schools in Peak Edge Trust.

*Children in Reception – Y2 and those receiving **Free School Meals** do not have to pay. Meanwhile, the local authority have confirmed they will again be providing vouchers to cover the school holidays – these should be with you during the week beginning 15th July.
